

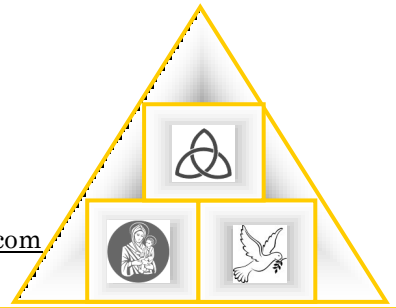

A whole new world is born when a person is baptized. The God of the universe enters into that soul and makes his home there so that the newly baptized person can have access to his infinite world of grace, holiness and wisdom through His Catholic Church.

God gives us His sanctifying grace which engenders the infused or theological virtues of divine faith, hope and love.

Every reasonable person can know that there must be a creator of the universe, and that the universe is ordered to the gift of life that comes from God.

Every reasonable person knows that only one mature man and one mature woman can bring about a new human person according to God's natural laws. And only a mature man and a mature woman can help that child be educated to fulfill a life of virtue.

But only those with divine faith, not a mere natural faith, believe that God has spoken to us through the Old Testament and New Testament, and continues to speak to us through Jesus Christ who is Head of His divine Church. Only those with divine faith believe everything that Jesus Christ teaches us, because he is the Son of God and the Son of Mary.

Jesus is a man of his word, because he is the Word of God incarnate. We are called to be men of our word; and when I use the word men, I mean it to be inclusive meaning all men, women and children who are at the age of reason. Only when a person has divine faith do they believe that God is one, but also that God is love and thus lives in a divine community of Eternal Life, Perfect Love, and Infinite Wisdom, three divine persons who are named Father, Son and Holy Spirit: the Holy Trinity.

In today's Gospel we hear that Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist, not because Jesus needed to have Original Sin be washed from him, but rather that the waters of baptism needed to be given the power to wash away our Original Sin so that we could become living members of Christ's Mystical body, the Church.

We have to go through the waters of baptism to become one with Jesus Christ. Thus, Jesus goes before us by being baptized by an imperfect man, John the Baptist, so that we might recognize that the perfect gift of baptism comes to us through imperfect priests

who have been given the power to baptize in the name of the Church. In the same way, these imperfect priests celebrate the other secondary rites of baptism to make the baptism more fruitful: the anointing with the Oil of the Catechuminate, and after receiving the waters of Baptism, the oil of Sacred Chrism, which is also used at Confirmation and Ordination by the Bishop and assisting priests.



The fruitfulness of one's baptism is interdependent upon the parents and godparents who are called to pray daily for their child and for one another: "Our Father, who are in heaven"... "give us this day our daily bread..."

This baptism gives us an indelible mark on our soul and creates a desire to receive Jesus Christ more and more until we become perfected in Christ and found perfectly worthy of the fullness of heaven.

That is why Jesus said in the Sermon on the Mount: "You must be perfect as your heavenly father is perfect." Those who follow the Commandments, the beatitudes, and teaches others to do the same will be called greatest in the Kingdom of Heaven. But if your holiness does not surpass those of the scribes you will be least in the kingdom of heaven.

Let us live out our baptismal call and so be found great in the Kingdom of Heaven! And let us lead our children along the same path, as every parent wants their children to surpass them in their spiritual life in order to help the rest of the family secure the fullness of heaven.

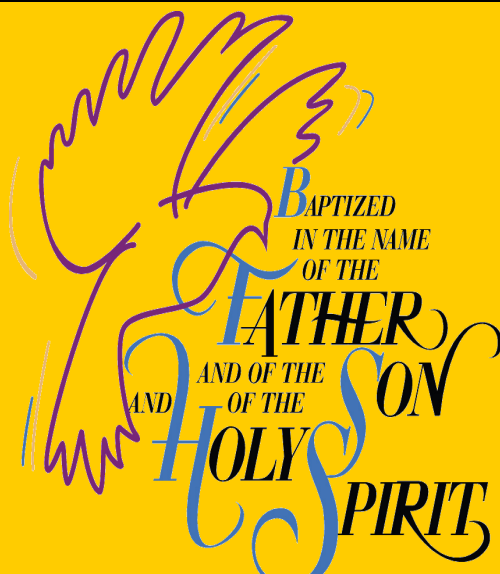
